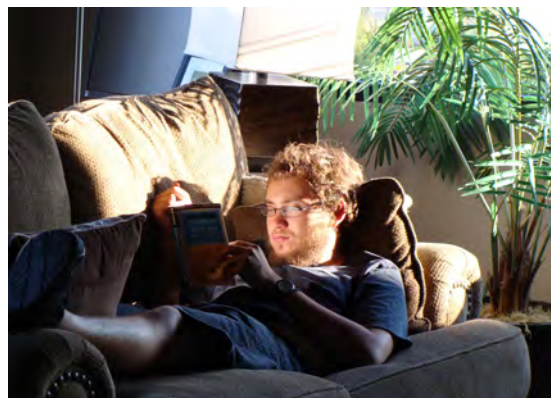

Summer Program Fast Facts

What: College Excel's Summer College Intensive. Earn 14 transferrable college credits while participating in the College Excel program and exploring the beautiful Northwest. The immersion style curriculum consists of credits in Speech, Shakespeare, Archeology and Writing. Each course has been designed for College Excel students and will be taught by a team of personable college professors. Subject matter is challenging, fun and experiential. Supervised study hours and tutors are available for students who need academic support.



Where: Home base will be on our beautiful Bend, Oregon campus. Students live in our fully equipped student housing, which provides an invaluable opportunity for them to make friends, live responsibly and learn independent living skills. Our housing consists of nicely furnished homes in great neighborhoods within walking distance to campus, our facilities, parks and downtown. Students will travel as a group exploring the best places in Oregon including mountain ranges, rivers, waterfalls, lakes, cities and spend four exciting days at the world renowned Ashland Shakespeare Festival.

Who: Academically motivated new or continuing college students in need of academic and/or personal support. The program provides a structured introduction or re-introduction to college without the constant everyday distractions and social expectations of typical campus life. Students are unsupervised in the evenings and have some weekends free.

Why: Opportunity to gain college and life experience in a fun, structured setting while making new friends, discovering new places, earning college credit and building personal confidence. Students benefit from one-on-one academic and life coaching as they are supported to become more self-reliant and work to sharpen the academic skills necessary to be a successful student at the college level. At the end of the Intensive, students will feel a sense of great accomplishment, have a higher level of self and academic confidence and enjoy a renewed passion for furthering their education.

Why College Excel? College Excel's resources, reputation, location and commitment to academic and personal excellence make it an ideal choice for those students looking for a leg up on their college experience. What's New: This summer we are extending our 9-week program to a normal 90 day term to provide our students with an amazing opportunity to achieve new levels of success and confidence. After summer academic courses end students will enjoy three weeks of fun-filled days with their friends as they work to accomplish a series of simulated challenges that require real world skills. Using the great outdoors as our classroom, students learn the fundamental principles of teamwork, communication, decision making, problem solving and leadership. In the last week of the course students travel to the Oregon coast for 4 days of celebration as they wrap up the summer and prepare for the start of their fall academic term.

Costs: \$19,450 Tuition* (All Inclusive)

The above fees include College Excel tuition, student housing, 14 college credits, academic and life coaching, LD support, breakfast and lunch weekdays, two dinners per week, travel and lodging, plus numerous activities. Students are expected to provide their own grocery and walking around money, personal items, medical costs, and books and supplies for the college courses.
